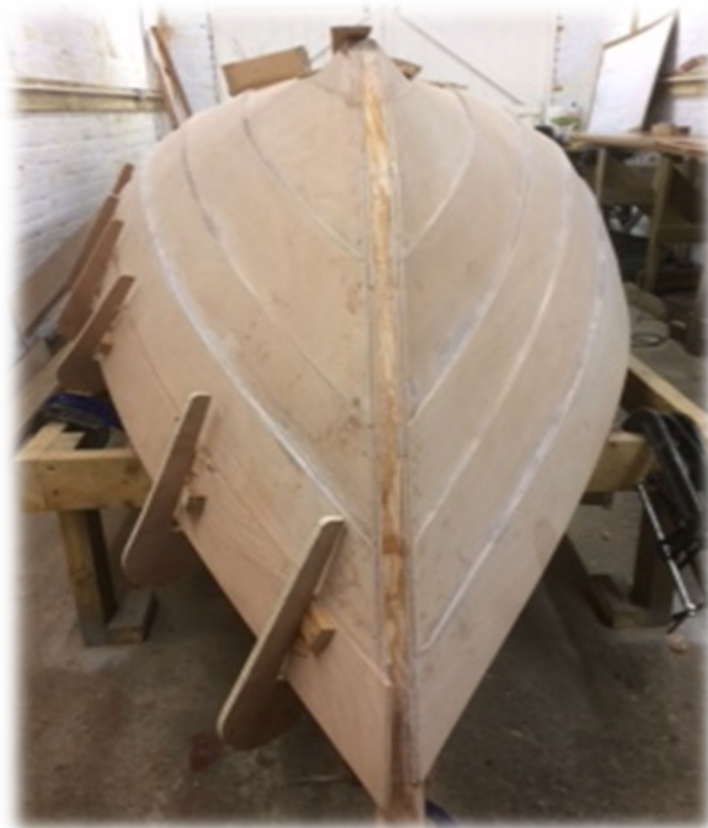




## Appin Community Skiff

## Help us find a name and colour scheme for our community boat

The competition is in two parts:

### 1. Colours for Appin's skiff

Choose at least two colours (3 at most) for the Appin Community Skiff, use the attached drawing to illustrate your colour choices. Page 4. Colour can be repeated on different parts of the boat and please ensure that the choice of colours can be seen when the skiff is on the sea.

### 2. A name for Appin's skiff

Suggest a suitable name; to help in choosing a name, please consider Skiff culture/heritage and our coastal locality. You can refer to the Scottish Skiff Register so as to avoid duplication of names: Page 4.

### Who is eligible to enter:

Everyone in the Appin area including primary and secondary school pupils, students, community groups and organisations, Appin Community Skiff Members and individuals.

### Judging:

A short-term working committee of members of the Appin Community Skiff will judge entries with the addition of a dual process for the naming of the skiff where 5 names will be shortlisted for a public vote. More information to follow in social media.

Use the entry form (overleaf) to suggest a name, colour scheme or both for our community coastal rowing skiff. For the colours, simply colour in the blank sketch.

### **Submit your entry by Thursday 25 April 2019**

A shortlist of names for a public vote will be issued by **10<sup>th</sup> May 2019** with the final winning name and colours announced soon thereafter.
